2. Acquiring and using knowledge and skills (cognition, communication, motor)	Code
<del>Looks at or points to pictures in a book when asked.</del>	
<del>Scribbles circular patterns.</del>	
Loves to color, but sometimes gets "stuck" and has difficulty transitioning to another activity.	O
Will sit quietly and listen during story time at the bookstore. Loves books and will look at them by herself or with an adult.	A
Is reluctant to explore unfamiliar places, but will do so with reassurance from mom or Miss Katy.	O

3. Taking appropriate actions to meet needs (cognition, adaptive/self-help, motor)	Code
<del>Drinks from a cup without assistance.</del>	
<del>Walks up and down stairs without assistance.</del>	
Is able to feed herself with utensils, but won't verbalize what she wants. Parents only know when she's hungry because she begins whining.	A N
Walks upstairs to her playroom and brings down toys she wants.	A
Loves the water, and will pull off her shirt and shorts at the swimming pool, but Mom has to put her swimsuit on her.	A
